1. Purpose

In this instance your data is being processed for the specific purpose of managing your employment.

2. Lawful Basis

4. Retention

5. Destruction

At the end of this retention period your data will be destroyed using an approved method unless prevented by Court order.

6. Data Sharing

Whilst we control your personal data we will need to share this data with the following parties, for the following purposes:

- 6.1. Parties whose details have been given to Barton Wyatt by the data subject for referencing purposes.
- 6.2. The Company's Bankers in order to pay employee's salary.
- 6.3. Providers of the Company's Employee Pension scheme, for the sole purpose of administering employee's pensions.
- 6.4. Human Resourcing advisers for the sole purpose of seeking professional advice, when necessary. The company does not retain a particular adviser in this regard. So, where data needs to be shared this can be advised as appropriate.
